

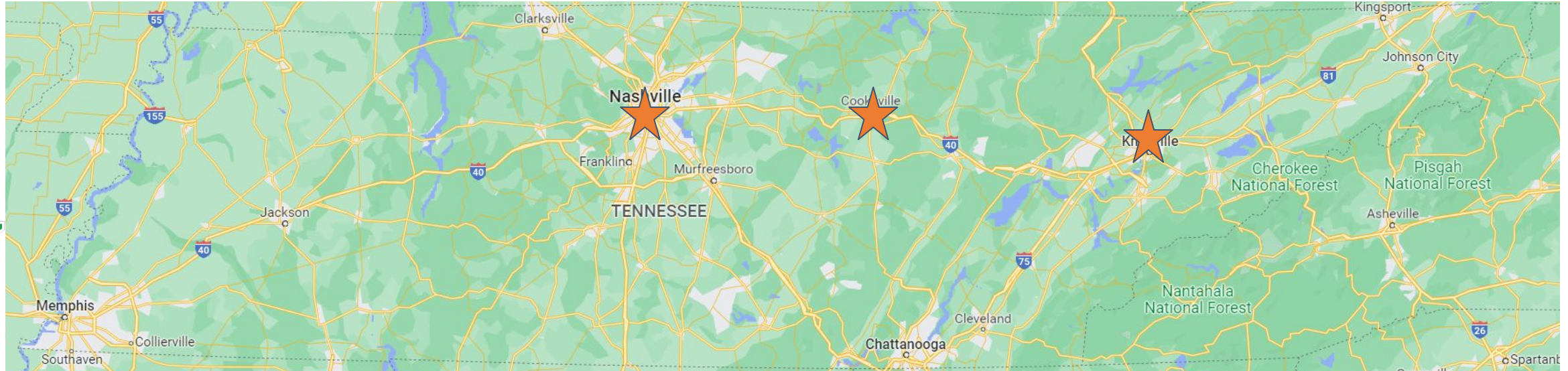

# Who is eligible?

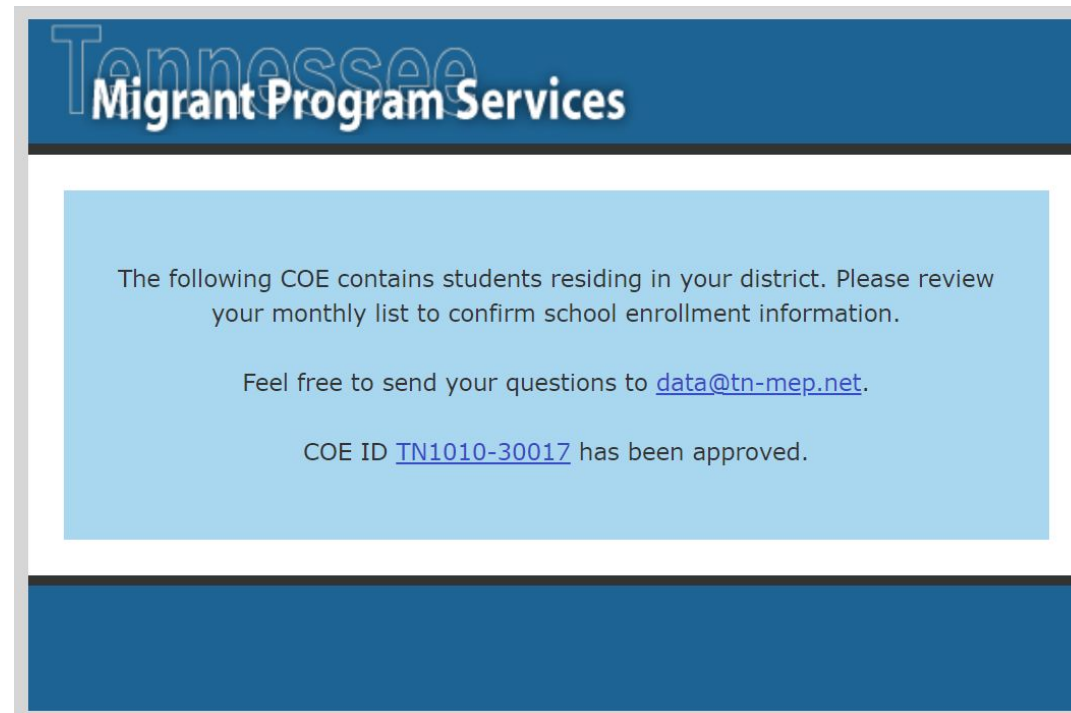
- Each migratory student must have a Certificate of Eligibility (COE) signed by Tennessee Department of Education to receive services
- If the Outreach and Enrollment team completes a COE for a child, they are eligible for the TN MEP

<b>Actively Sought</b> – having taken positive actions to look for new qualifying work.	<b>Activamente Buscando</b> – haber tomado medidas positivas para encontrar nuevo trabajo que califique.
<b>Agricultural Work</b> – the production or initial processing of raw agricultural products, such as crops, poultry, livestock; dairy work; as well as the cultivation or harvesting of trees that is performed for wages or personal subsistence.	<b>Trabajo Agrícola</b> – la producción o el procesamiento inicial de productos agrícolas crudos, como cultivo, aves de corral, ganado; trabajo lácteo; así como el cultivo o cosecha de árboles que se realiza por salario o subsistencia personal.

An individual who made a Qualifying Move and, soon after the move, engaged in new Qualifying Work.

Does the “individual” meet the definition of “**Migratory Qualifying Worker**”?

## QUALIFYING MOVE FOR MIGRATORY QUALIFYING WORKER

- Due to economic necessity; AND
- From one residence to another residence; AND
- From one district to another; AND
- Took place in the preceding 36 months

## QUALIFYING WORK FOR MIGRATORY QUALIFYING WORKER

- engaged in new temporary or seasonal employment or personal subsistence in agriculture soon after the move (within 60 days);

### AND

- The new qualifying work is seasonal or temporary; AND
- The new qualifying work is agricultural or fishing



# What is a Qualifying Move?

A move made under the following conditions:

- due to economic necessity,
- from one residence to another,
- from one school district to another, and
- within the past 36 months





# What is a Qualifying Move?

## Due to Economic Necessity

- Not being able to afford to stay in the current location
- Moving in order to earn a living





# What is a Qualifying Move?

The Migratory Child's and the Migratory Qualifying Worker's moves must be...

From one

To live and not just to visit.

**Does not include:**

- Visiting family or friends
- Attending a wedding
- Taking a vacation
- Taking care of "legal" matters

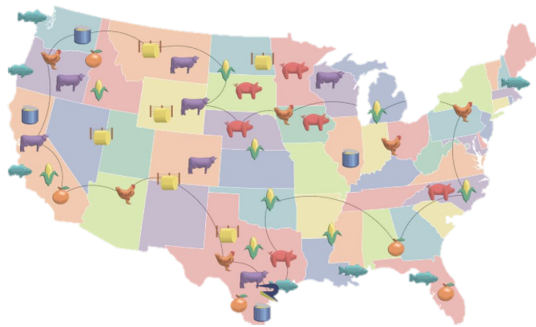

The moves have to be TO the US and/or its territories

# What is Qualifying Work?

“New **temporary or seasonal employment** or personal subsistence in the **production or initial processing of agriculture or fishing products**”



# Qualifying Work

Soon After the Move (*within 60 days*), the individual **engaged** in new:

- **temporary or seasonal employment or personal subsistence**
- in the production or initial processing of
- agriculture or fishing products





# Qualifying Work

“Seasonal or Temporary Employment”

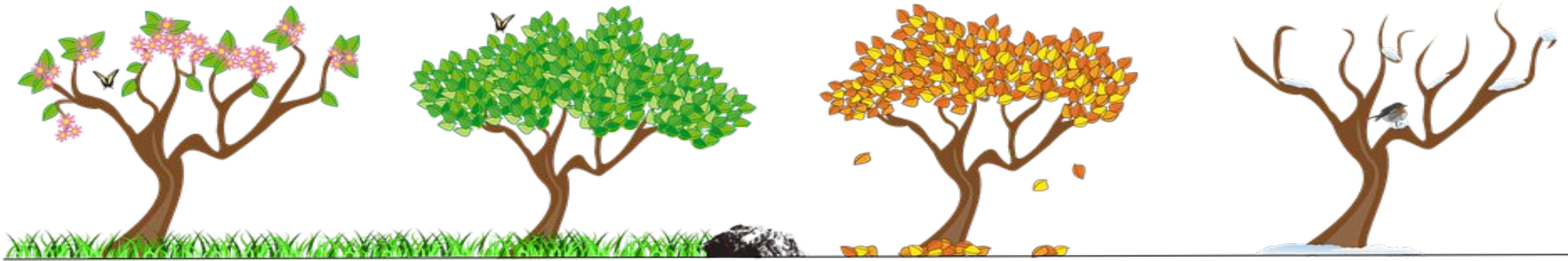
Neither seasonal nor temporary  
employment may last longer than 12  
months



# Qualifying Work

## “**Seasonal** or Temporary Employment”

**Seasonal** – Employment that occurs only during a certain period of the year because of the cycles of nature and that, by its nature, may not be continuous or carried on throughout the year.

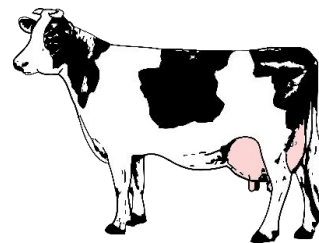
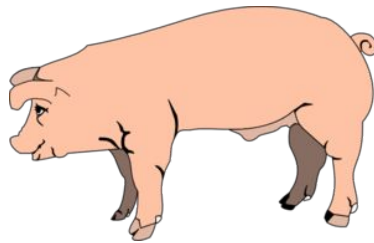
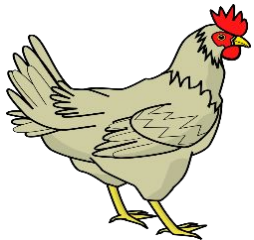


# Qualifying Work

## “Seasonal or **Temporary** Employment”

**Temporary** – Employment that lasts for a limited period of time, usually a few months, but no longer than 12 months.

- The **worker states** he/she does not intend to remain in that employment indefinitely (i.e., the worker’s employment will not last longer than 12 months).
- **Employer states** that worker was hired for a limited timeframe, not to exceed 12 months.





# Qualifying Work

## “Personal Subsistence”

**Personal Subsistence** – The worker and the worker’s family, as a matter of economic necessity, consume, as a substantial portion of their food intake, the crops, dairy products, or livestock they produce or the fish they catch.



# Qualifying Work

Soon After the Move (*within 60 days*), the individual **engaged** in new:

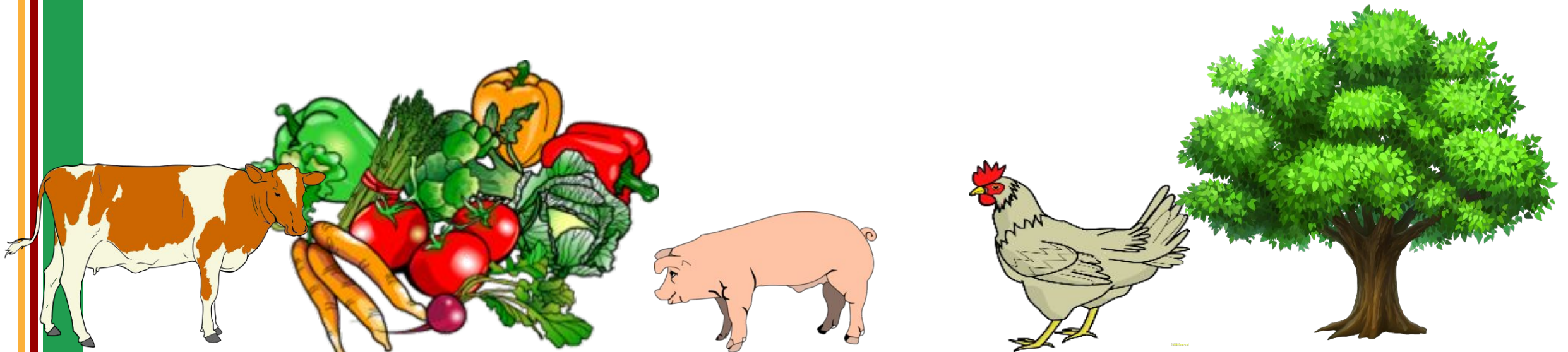

# Qualifying Work

## “Agricultural or Fishing”

**Agricultural Work** – The production or initial processing of crops, dairy products, poultry, or livestock, and the cultivation, harvesting and initial processing of trees. It consists of work performed for wages or personal subsistence.

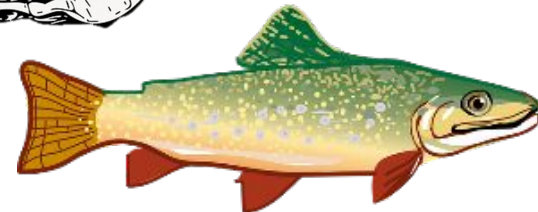
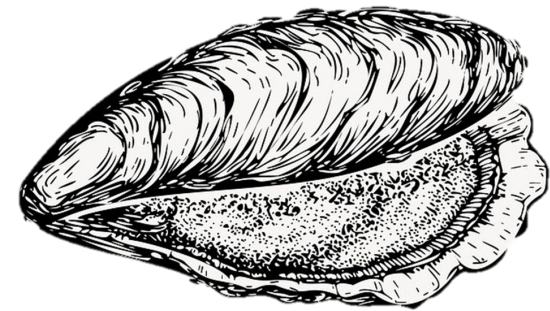
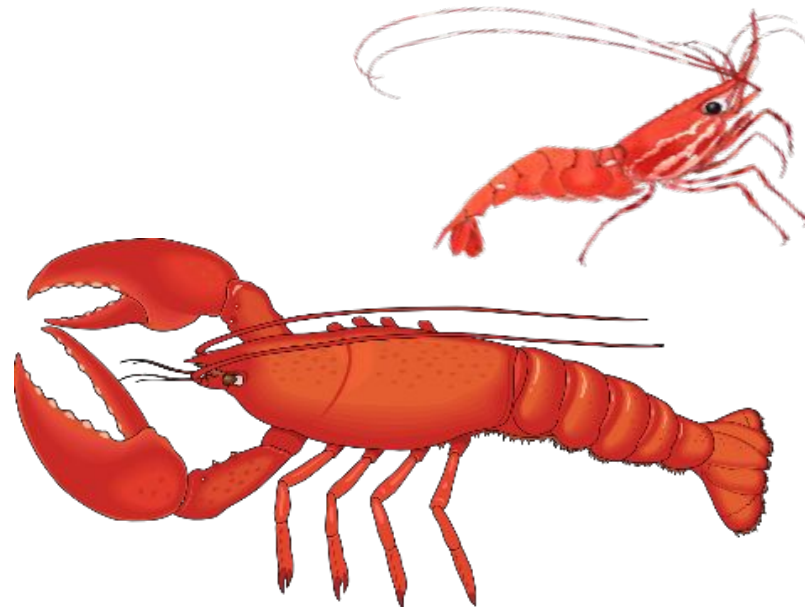




# Qualifying Work

“Agricultural or **Fishing**”

**Fishing Work** – The catching or initial processing of fish or shellfish; as well as the raising or harvesting of fish or shellfish at fish farms that is performed for wages or personal subsistence.

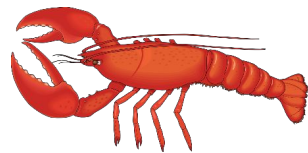
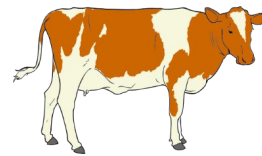
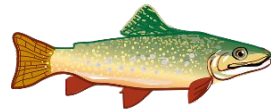




# Qualifying Work

## “Production or Initial Processing”

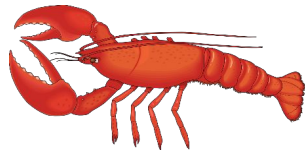
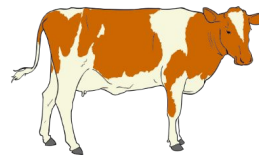
**Production** – Work in growing and harvesting of crops, plants and the keeping, grazing and feeding livestock, and catching, raising and harvesting fish



# Qualifying Work

## “Production or Initial Processing”

**Initial Processing** – work that (1) is beyond the production stage of qualifying work and (2) precedes the transformation of the raw product into something more refined. It means working with a raw agricultural or fishing product.

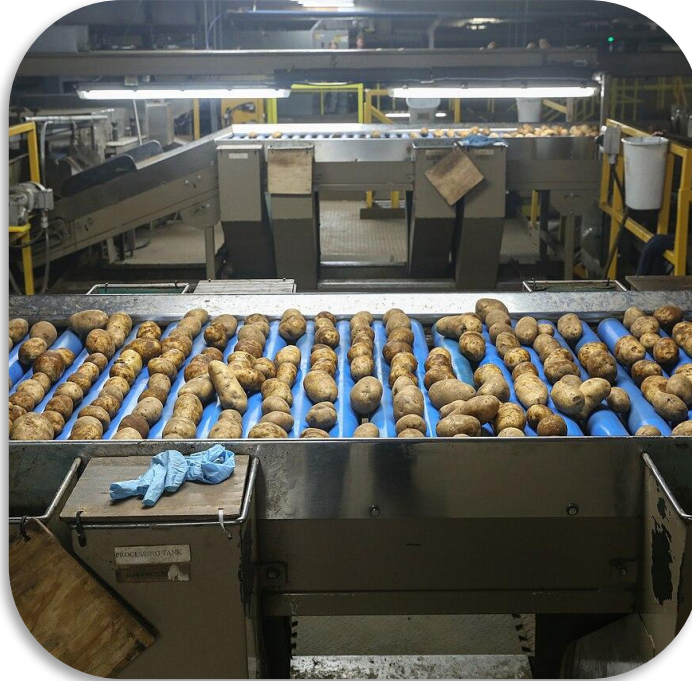

# Migratory Child (MC)?

A child that is younger than 22 years of age and is entitled to a free and public education under State law, and made a qualifying move as, with to join or precede a migratory qualifying worker

Do(es) the “child(ren)” meet the definition of a “**Migratory Child**”?

## AGE

- The child is younger than 22 years of age

## SCHOOL COMPLETION

- The child is eligible for a free public education under State law

## QUALIFYING MOVE FOR CHILD

- Due to economic necessity; AND
- From one residence to another residence; AND
- From one district to another; AND
- Took place in the preceding 36 months

# Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD):

The date that both the Migratory Child and the Migratory Qualifying Worker complete their qualifying moves together.

The child must have moved as, with, to join or precede the Migratory Qualifying Worker. This date begins the child's 36 months of eligibility in the Migrant Education Program

# Qualifying Arrival Date – (QAD)



If the child and the Migratory Qualifying Worker (MQW) moved together,

the **QAD** is the day they both arrive.



If the child moved to precede the MQW,

the **QAD** is the day the worker arrives.



If the MQW moved before the child, ...

the **QAD** is the day the child arrives.



# Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD):

The date that both the Migratory Child and the Migratory Qualifying Worker complete their qualifying moves together.

**Qualifying Arrival Date (QAD): Both Child and Worker must make a “Qualifying Move.”**

- The child moved: (check one)
  - as** a Migratory Qualifying Worker (MQW),
  - with**, a Migratory Qualifying Worker (MQW), or
  - to join** a parent/guardian or spouse who is the Migratory Qualifying Worker (MQW).



# Who is eligible?

- Our Eligibility Checklist:
  - Migratory Qualifying Worker – An individual who made a qualifying move and engaged in Qualifying Work Soon After the Move
  - Migratory Child - A child under 22 years old, eligible for free public education, and made a Qualifying Move as, with to join or precede a Migratory Qualifying Worker
  - Qualifying Arrival Date - The last time the Migratory Child and the Migratory Qualifying Worker



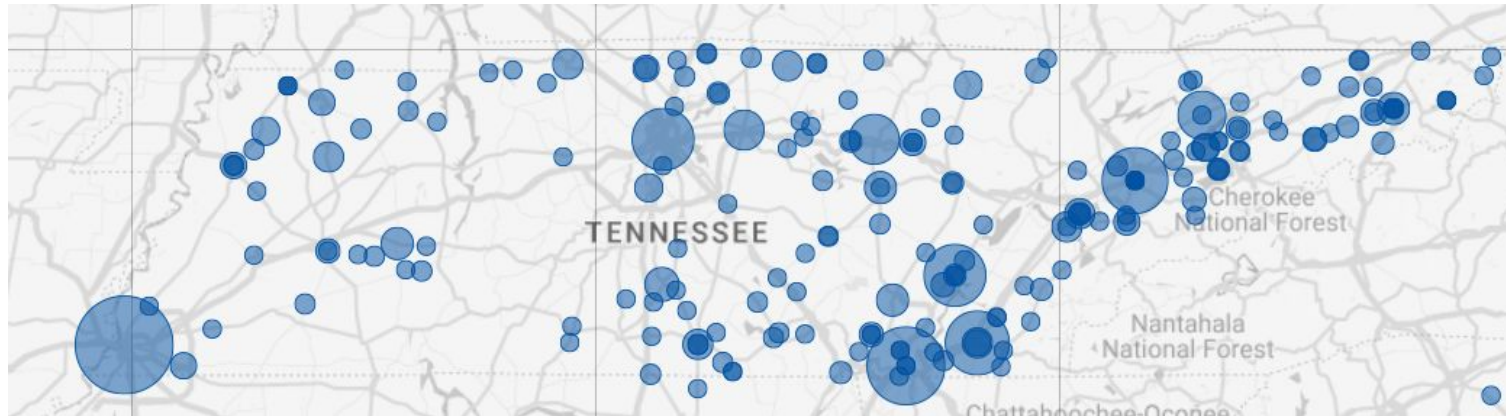
